

Research Ethics Assignment

Due date: Sept. 2nd, noon

This assignment tasks you with doing the required training, and providing the required documentation, to be able to participate in our course research project. Once you have completed the tasks below, I will send your information to the Howard University Institutional Review Board that reviews applications to conduct research in order to maintain ethical research practices that do no harm to the people who we will be interviewing.

This assignment has two main parts:

1. Take the short online courses the “Human Subjects Research” and “Responsible Conduct of Research” provided by the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative.
 - a. Go to <https://www.citiprogram.org>
 - b. Click the “create an account” button on right of screen
 - c. Search for “Howard University Medical Center” and select it from the drop-down menu
 - d. Finish creating your (free) account
 - e. “Add” the following courses:
 - i. Responsible Conduct of Research
 1. Social and Behaviors Responsible Conduct of Research Course
 - ii. Human Subjects Research
 1. Group 2: Social/Humanistic/Behavioral Research
 - f. Take and pass the two mini-courses.
 - g. Submit your certificate of completion of education for both “courses” into the assignments section of Blackboard. These should be the “full” certificates that show your name, the name of the course, and your score.
2. Create or update your Curriculum Vitae (CV). Note that a CV does not require you to describe what you have done at current or previous jobs, only to list the job itself. You do not need to include people who can provide references for you on this CV. Do not provide a photograph. Do include your full name, e-mail address, phone number, mailing address, educational experience, work experience, and any of the following that apply to you: awards/grants/fellowships/honors, publications, off-campus presentations, community service in which you participate, student groups in which you participate or have leadership roles.
